CLEMATIS PRUNING GROUPS

A - Small-flowered species and their cultivars, flowering early spring on last season's growth. Minimal pruning required. Remove dead or damaged stems, and lightly shape plant after flowering if desired.

B - Large-flowered cultivars, flowering in the summer on the previous year's growth. Some flower again in summer on current season's growth. To prune, remove dead and damaged stems in early spring before growth begins, trimming all remaining stems to a pair of strong buds.

C - Large-flowered cultivars, small-flowered species and their cultivars, and herbaceous species, flowering late summer on current season's growth. To prune, cut back all growth to a pair of strong buds 6-8 inches above soil level, before growth begins in early spring.
