Botanical Name	Common Name	Fall Color
<i>Acer buergerianum</i>	Trident Maple	Yellow, orange, red - variable
<i>Acer circinatum</i>	Vine Maple	Yellow, orange, red - variable. Can be brilliant.
<i>Acer davidii</i>	David Maple	Yellow to Orange, variable by tree
<i>Acer ginnala</i>	Amur Maple	Mostly red, rarely some yellow ('Flame' is Red)
<i>Acer grandidentatum</i> 'Rocky Mountain Glow'	Rocky Mountain Glow Maple	Orange-red. Intense
<i>Acer griseum</i>	Paperbark Maple	Deep red
<i>Acer japonicum</i> 'Aconitifolium'	Fernleaf Fullmoon Maple	Crimson
<i>Acer japonicum</i> 'Aurea'	Golden Fullmoon Maple	Yellow
<i>Acer japonicum</i> 'Vitifolium'	Fullmoon Maple	Yellow to Purple
<i>Acer negundo</i>	Box Elder	'Sensation' is Red, most others yellow to brown
<i>Acer palmatum</i>	Japanese Maple	Variable. Yellow-red, often at the same time
<i>Acer pensylvanicum</i>	Striped Maple	Vibrant Yellow
<i>Acer platanoides</i>	Norway Maple	Yellow
<i>Acer platanoides</i> 'Columnare'	Columnar Norway Maple	Yellow
<i>Acer platanoides</i> 'Crimson King'	Crimson King Norway Maple	Maroon to red-bronze
<i>Acer platanoides</i> 'Crimson Sentry'	Crimson Sentry Norway Maple	Maroon to red-bronze
<i>Acer platanoides</i> 'Drummondii'	Variiegated Norway Maple	Two-tone yellow
<i>Acer pseudoplatanus</i> 'Spaethii'	Spaeth Sycamore Maple	Brown-Yellow
<i>Acer rubrum</i>	Red Maple	Red, sometimes yellow. Can be variable.
<i>Acer rubrum</i> 'Armstrong'	Armstrong Columnar Red Maple	Orange-red, variable depending on many factors
<i>Acer rubrum</i> 'Autumn Flame'	Autumn Flame Red Maple	Brilliant Red, colors early
<i>Acer rubrum</i> 'Bowhall'	Bowhall Red Maple	Yellow-Red, variable depending on many factors
<i>Acer rubrum</i> 'Magnificent Magenta'	Burgundy Belle Red Maple	Deep red-burgundy
<i>Acer rubrum</i> 'October Glory'	October Glory Red Maple	Orange-Red, very reliable
<i>Acer rubrum</i> 'Red Sunset'	Red Sunset Maple	Red to red-orange. Brilliant and reliable
<i>Acer saccharum</i>	Sugar Maple	Yellow, orange, rarely red
<i>Acer saccharum</i> 'Belle Tower'	Belle Tower Sugar Maple	Orange-Yellow
<i>Acer saccharum</i> 'Green Mountain'	Green Mountain Sugar Maple	Orange
<i>Acer saccharum</i> 'Legacy'	Legacy Sugar Maple	Orange-Red
<i>Acer triflorum</i>	Three-flowered Maple	Yellow to red, orange in appearance
<i>Acer trunc x plat</i> 'Keithsform'	Norwegian Sunset Maple	Yellow-orange to Red
<i>Acer trunc x plat</i> 'Pacific Sunset'	Pacific Sunset Maple	Yellow-orange to bright red. Stunning.
<i>Acer tschonoskii</i> ssp. <i>Koreanum</i>	Tschonoski Maple	Orange to Red
<i>Acer x freemanii</i> 'Autumn Blaze'	Autumn Blaze Maple	Brilliant Orange-Red, long lasting
<i>Aesculus</i> spp.	Horsechestnut	Yellow, uninteresting
<i>Albizia julibrissin</i>	Silk Tree	Yellow to golden
<i>Amelanchier grandiflora</i> 'Autumn Brilliance'	Autumn Brilliance Serviceberry	Brilliant Red
<i>Betula</i> spp.	Birch	All green leaved forms have great yellow color
<i>Carpinus betulus</i> 'Fastigiatus'	Columnar Hornbeam	Yellow
<i>Cercidiphyllum japonicum</i>	Katsura Tree	Peach colored (yellow-orange), rarely reddish
<i>Cercis canadensis</i> 'Forest Pansy'	Forest Pansy Redbud	Yellow-orange
<i>Cercis canadensis</i> and <i>chinensis</i> varieties	Redbud	Yellow
<i>Chionanthus retusus</i>	Chinese Fringe Trees	Yellow
<i>Cladrastis lutea</i> (kentukea)	Yellow wood	Yellow
<i>Cornus</i> varieties	Flowering Dogwood	Usually Red, not reliable on most species
<i>Cotinus coggygia</i> 'Grace'	Grace Smoke Tree	Bright orange to red. Brilliant coloration
<i>Cotinus coggygia</i> 'Royal Purple'	Royal Purple Smoke Tree	Bright orange to red
<i>Fagus sylvatica</i> varieties	Beech	Most are golden-golden brown
<i>Fraxinus americana</i> 'Autumn Purple'	Autumn Purple Ash	Reddish purple
<i>Fraxinus americana</i> 'Rosehill'	Rosehill Ash	Bronze Red to Purple
<i>Fraxinus oxycarpa</i> 'Raywood'	Raywood Ash	Reddish purple - outstanding

<i>Fraxinus pennsylvanica</i> 'Cimmzam'	Cimmaron Ash	Orange-red to brick red
<i>Fraxinus pennsylvanica</i> 'Marshall Seedless'	Marshall's Seedless Ash	Bright Yellow
<i>Fraxinus pennsylvanica</i> 'Rugby'	Prairie Spire Ash	Bright Golden Yellow
<i>Fraxinus pennsylvanica</i> 'Summit'	Summit Ash	Bright Yellow
<i>Ginkgo biloba</i> varieties	Ginkgo	Clear Yellow
<i>Gleditsia triacanthos</i> 'Skyline'	Skyline Honeylocust	Golden Yellow
<i>Gleditsia triacanthos</i> 'Sunburst'	Sunburst Honeylocust	Yellow-brown
<i>Halesia carolina</i>	Carolina Silverbell	Yellow
<i>Koelreuteria paniculata</i>	Golden Rain Tree	Yellow
<i>Laburnum</i> varieties	Golden Chain Tree	Yellow
<i>Liquidambar styraciflua</i>	Sweetgum	Yellow, red, purple - variable but showy
<i>Liquidambar styraciflua</i> 'Cherokee'	Cherokee Sweetgum	Burgundy-red, a little yellow
<i>Liquidambar styraciflua</i> 'Moraine'	Moraine Sweetgum	Brilliant Red
<i>Liquidambar styraciflua</i> 'Worplesdon'	Worplesdon Sweetgum	Orange and Purple
<i>Liriodendron tulipifera</i>	Tulip Tree	Bright Yellow
<i>Malus</i> varieties	Crabapple	Yellow to red. Variable, usually not interesting
<i>Nyssa sylvatica</i>	Sour Gum, Black Tupelo	Copper Red
<i>Oxydendrum arboreum</i>	Sourwood	Orange-scarlet, some yellow
<i>Parrotia persica</i>	Persian Parrotia	Yellow, orange, red
<i>Platanus acerifolia</i> and varieties	London Plane Tree	Yellow, insignificant
<i>Populus nigra</i> 'Italica'	Lombardy Poplar	Yellow
<i>Populus tremuloides</i>	Quaking Aspen	Clear yellow
<i>Prunus ceracifera</i> varieties	Flowering Plums	Generally insignificant
<i>Prunus padus</i> 'Merlot', 'Summer Glow'	European Bird Cherry	Red to Reddish Purple
<i>Prunus serrula</i>	Copper Bark Cherry	Yellow, some orange
<i>Prunus serrulata</i> 'Kwanzan'	Kwanzan Flowering Cherry	Orange-red
<i>Prunus serrulata</i> 'Royal Burgundy'	Royal Burgundy Flowering Cherry	Bronze-purple
<i>Prunus serrulata</i> 'Shirofugen'	Shirofugen Flowering Cherry	Orange
<i>Prunus serrulata</i> 'Shirotae'	Mount Fuji Flowering Cherry	Yellow
<i>Prunus serrulata</i> 'Shogetsu'	Shogetsu Flowering Cherry	Orange-red
<i>Prunus virginiana</i> 'Canada Red'	Canada Red Chokecherry	Red to Reddish-Purple
<i>Prunus</i> x 'Accolade'	Accolade Flowering Cherry	Yellow-bronze-red
<i>Prunus</i> x 'Blirieana'	Blirieana Flowering Plum	Reddish bronze
<i>Prunus</i> x 'Hally Jolivette'	Hally Jolivette Flowering Cherry	Yellow
<i>Prunus</i> x 'Okame'	Okame Flowering Cherry	Golden to orange-red
<i>Prunus</i> x 'Snow Fountain'	Snow Fountain Weeping Cherry	Golden orange
<i>Prunus</i> x <i>yedoensis</i> ; x <i>yedoensis</i> 'Akebono'	Yoshino/Akebono Flowering Cherries	Yellow
<i>Pyrus calleryana</i> 'Aristocrat'	Aristocrat Flowering Pear	Deep red
<i>Pyrus calleryana</i> 'Capital'	Capital Flowering Pear	Red
<i>Pyrus calleryana</i> 'Cleveland Select'	Cleveland Select Flowering Pear	Reddish Purple
<i>Pyrus calleryana</i> 'Redspire'	Redspire Flowering Pear	Usually Red, occasionally yellow
<i>Quercus coccinea</i>	Scarlet Oak	Deep Red. Showy
<i>Quercus palustris</i>	Pin Oak	Rusty Orange-Red to Brown
<i>Quercus robur</i> 'Fastigiata'	Columnar English Oak	Yellow-brown
<i>Quercus rubra</i>	Red Oak	Deep Red. Nice
<i>Robinia pseudoacacia</i> 'Purple Robe'	Purple Robe Locust	Yellow
<i>Salix</i> varieties	Willow	Most are Yellow
<i>Sorbus aucuparia</i> 'Royal Cardinal'	Royal Cardinal Mountain Ash	Rust color
<i>Stewartia monadelphica</i>	Tall Stewartia	Deep Reddish-maroon
<i>Stewartia pseudocamellia</i>	Japanese Stewartia	Orange to Reddish-purple. Some Yellow
<i>Stewartia sinensis</i>	Chinese Stewartia	Reddish
<i>Styrax japonicus</i>	Japanese Snowbell	Yellow
<i>Styrax obassia</i>	Fragrant Snowbell	Yellow - Not Showy
<i>Tilia cordata</i> and <i>tomentosa</i> varieties	Linden	Yellow
<i>Ulmus parviflora</i> 'Emer I'	Athena Elm	Yellow
<i>Ulmus parviflora</i> 'Emer II'	Allee Elm	Yellow to Orange-red
<i>Zelkova serrata</i> 'Village Green'	Village Green Zelkova	Reddish Orange
