Sizes listed are average heights for healthy plants after 10-15 years in a landscape.

Bloom time will vary slightly from year to year depending on weather. Early usually means February, and Late will stretch into June.

Bloom colors can also vary slightly depending on location, health, weather, and other factors. The general color will remain the same though and usually color variances are only really noticeable in adverse conditions.

The rating numbers correspond to Flower/Plant and Foliage/Performance. All Rhodies are unique though, so even though the ratings for some may not be as high as others, certain attributes may make them more worthwhile in your garden. So choose based on your preferences, and use the ratings as a secondary tool.
